### INTERNATIONAL SUMMER MUSIC COURSES 2024

**CONCERTO PROGRAM:** (Piano): Students who are participating in this division will receive a total of five lessons: 3 private lessons and 2 lessons (rehearsals with orchestra). **JUNIOR DIVISION** and **SENIOR DIVISION** will work with *Orchestra Sinfonica del Festival di Chioggia* (Pietro Perini, Conductor).

**JUNIOR DIVISION:** 30 – minutes rehearsal € 450  
**SENIOR DIVISION:** 40 – minutes rehearsal € 450

**SOLO PROGRAM:** Students will work on their solo repertoire. They will receive a total of 4 private lessons and will perform during festival's concert series, in workshops and in master classes € 350

**REGISTRATION FEE:** € 200 for CONCERTO PROGRAM  
€ 130 for SOLO PROGRAM

**Dead line registration: May 15th 2024**

## PERFORMANCES

During the festival some of the students may be chosen to give one or more performances as soloists, in Chamber Music Concerts or as soloists with orchestra during festival's concert series.

### 2024 "CITTÀ DI CHIOGGIA" COMPETITIONS

Summer International Music Festival will also include an opportunity for the young pianists to compete at the "*Città di Chioggia*" Concerto and Solo Competition.

#### SENIOR DIVISION CONCERTO Competition (over 16)

**Only those students, who perform at least 2 movements from the required concerto repertoire, are eligible to participate in the Senior Division Concerto Gala.**

**REQUIREMENTS:** Each participant has to demonstrate to the conductor at the first rehearsal that he/she can freely perform this work with the orchestra. If there are many candidates for a performance of the same concerto / movement of the concerto, Piano Faculty and M° Pietro Perini will make the final decision at the second rehearsal as to who will appear at the concert.

**WINNERS' GALA:** Those participants who successfully participated at both rehearsals and were chosen by Piano Faculty and M° Pietro Perini will appear in concert and will be accompanied by *Orchestra Sinfonica del Festival di Chioggia*, under the direction of M° Pietro Perini **on July 12<sup>th</sup> at 9:15 PM** in Piazzetta Vigo or at Auditorium San Nicolo.

#### REQUIRED CONCERTO REPERTOIRE FOR 2024:

- Fryderyk Chopin: Piano Concerto No. 1 in E Minor, op. 11
- Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart: Piano Concerto No.20 in D Minor, Kv 466
- Johannes Brahms: Piano Concerto n. 1 in D Minor op. 15

#### JUNIOR DIVISION CONCERTO COMPETITION

Group A: 6 – 12 years old  
Group B: 13 – 16 years old

**Only those students, who perform 1 movement from the required concerto repertoire, are eligible to participate in the Junior Division Concerto Competition. It is allowed to perform more than one movement**

**REQUIREMENTS:** Each participant has to demonstrate to the conductor at the first rehearsal that he/she can freely perform this work with the orchestra. If there are many candidates for a performance of the same concerto / movement of the concerto, Piano Faculty and M° Pietro Perini will make the final decision at the second rehearsal as to who will appear at the concert.

**WINNERS' GALA:** Those participants who successfully participated at both rehearsals and were chosen by Piano Faculty and M° Pietro Perini will appear in concert and will be accompanied by *Orchestra Sinfonica del Festival di Chioggia*, under the direction of M° Pietro Perini **on July 9<sup>th</sup> at 9:15 PM** at Palazzo Grassi courtyard or St. Nicolò Auditorium (in case of other venue will be announce during the course)

- W. A. MOZART: Concert for Piano and Strings n. 8 in C Major KV. 246
- J. S. BACH : Concerto N. 1 in F Minor BWV 1056
- F. J. Haydn: Divertimenti for Piano and Strings

### Group B: 13 – 16 years old

- L. van Beethoven: Piano Concerto No. 2, in B Flat Major, Op. 19 (Only Strings)
- L. van Beethoven: Piano Concerto No. 3, in C Minor, Op. 37 (Only Strings)
- W. A. Mozart: Piano Concerto n. 20 in D Major K.466 (Only Strings)
- W. A. Mozart: Piano Concerto n. 8 in C Major KV. 246 (Only Strings)
- J. S. Bach: Piano Concerto in F Minor, BWV 1056

### SENIOR DIVISION SOLO PIANO COMPETITION (OVER 16)

In order to be eligible to participate in this event, the students must register by May 15th, 2024. They must submit Festival application, registration fee and proposed competition repertoire.

**COMPETITION:** (open to the public) will take place during the festival, on July 11<sup>th</sup>, at 9:15 pm at the St. Nicolò Auditorium in Chioggia. Each participant will perform a 15 minute-long solo program which must include one piece from either Classical or Baroque period, one virtuoso piece and one piece of his/her own free choice.

Each program shall be approved by Festival administration in advance.

**JURY/ AWARDS:** Piano Faculty Members and one orchestra representative (Conductor) from the Summer International Music Festival will serve as jury members. The Gold, Silver and Bronze winner, will be awarded with certificates. **The jury reserves the right to either disqualify or penalize each participant that does not respect the required timing. The jury also reserves the right not to award all of the prizes.**

### JUNIOR DIVISION SOLO COMPETITION

Group A: 6 – 12 years old

Group B: 13 – 16 years old

Each program shall be approved by Festival administration in advance.

**JURY/ AWARDS:** Piano Faculty Members and one orchestra representative (Conductor) from the Summer International Music Festival will serve as jury members. The Gold, Silver and Bronze winner, will be awarded with certificates **The jury reserves the right to either disqualify or penalize each participant that does not respect the required timing. The jury also reserves the right not to award all of the prizes.**
